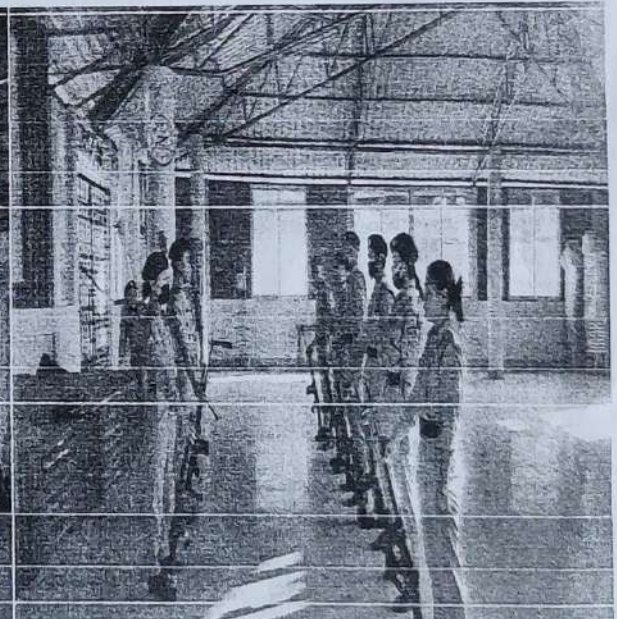
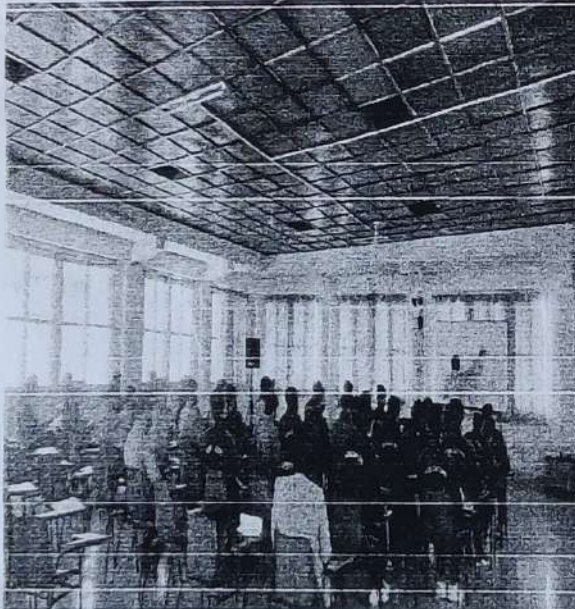
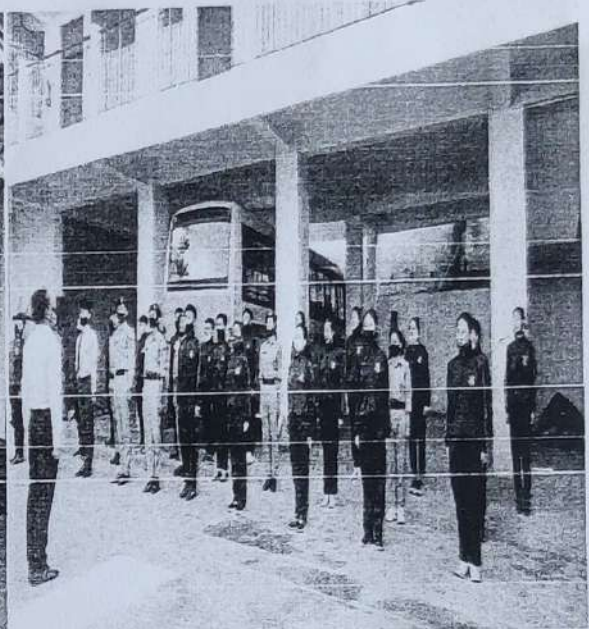
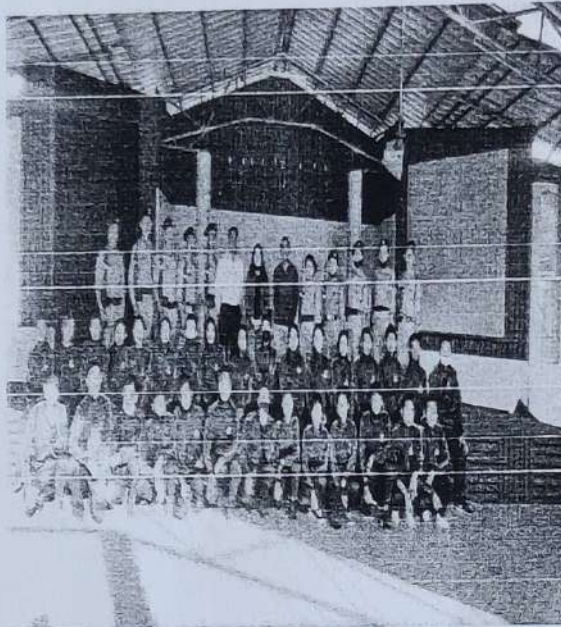


Report on NCC Class.
