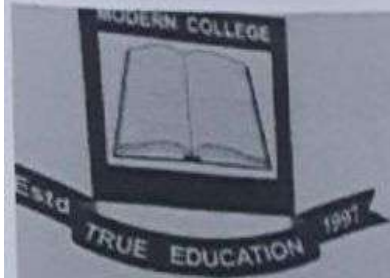

I. Proceedings of the October 24, 2020 Webinar on "Implementation of Domestic Violence Act and Effectiveness Thereof" by Modern College, Kohima, Nagaland

Sponsored by National Commission for Women, Government of India

The Webinar on "Implementation of Domestic Violence Act and Effectiveness Thereof" was conducted by Modern College, Kohima on October 24, 2020 Saturday from 1 PM to 3 PM. The programme was anchored by the Gender Champion Club of the college. The entire Webinar can be divided into three sessions. Session I began with the Moderator giving an opening remark on the Webinar and introducing the three Resource Persons. It was followed by Welcome Address by the Principal of Modern College. Session II was taken up by the three Resource Persons. Each speaker was allotted about 45 minutes to speak on their topic. Session III had questions and answers round with audience raising questions taken up by the resource persons. The Q&A round was followed by feedback and thanking all for the active participating and concluding the webinar.

Session I:

The moderator of the programme, Ms Weche-ü Thahu, Asst. Professor began the first session with a short introduction on the topic, the National Commission for Women and its objectives and the relevance of holding the Webinar during this pandemic time. She highlighted the growing number and incidences of women and children being major victims of domestic violence as normal lives and livelihoods of people are severely affected all over the country and Nagaland not being spared.

She then invited Dr H P Singh, Principal, Modern College, Kohima to deliver the welcome address. Dr H P Singh welcomed all the Resource Persons and thanked them for giving their time to be part of the Webinar. With their rich experience background and experience and having worked in the field for many years, he expressed that the sessions will contribute towards bringing awareness amongst young people and also workable solutions. The Principal highlighted that domestic violence, though a relevant social issue, is unfortunately one of the least talked about due to several societal norms. He stated that young people should be part of the conversation and play active role in addressing this issue.

He also thanked and welcomed officials from NCW, Govt of India. He expressed gratitude to the NCW for sponsoring the Webinar. Further he welcomed all the participants comprising of teachers, research scholars, students, social and development workers and concerned citizens to the Webinar.
