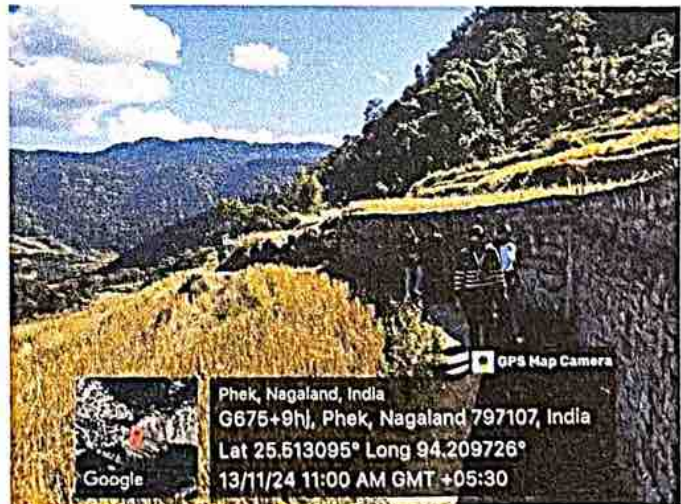


REPORT ON THE DEPARTMENT FIELD TRIP TO KHEZHAKENO

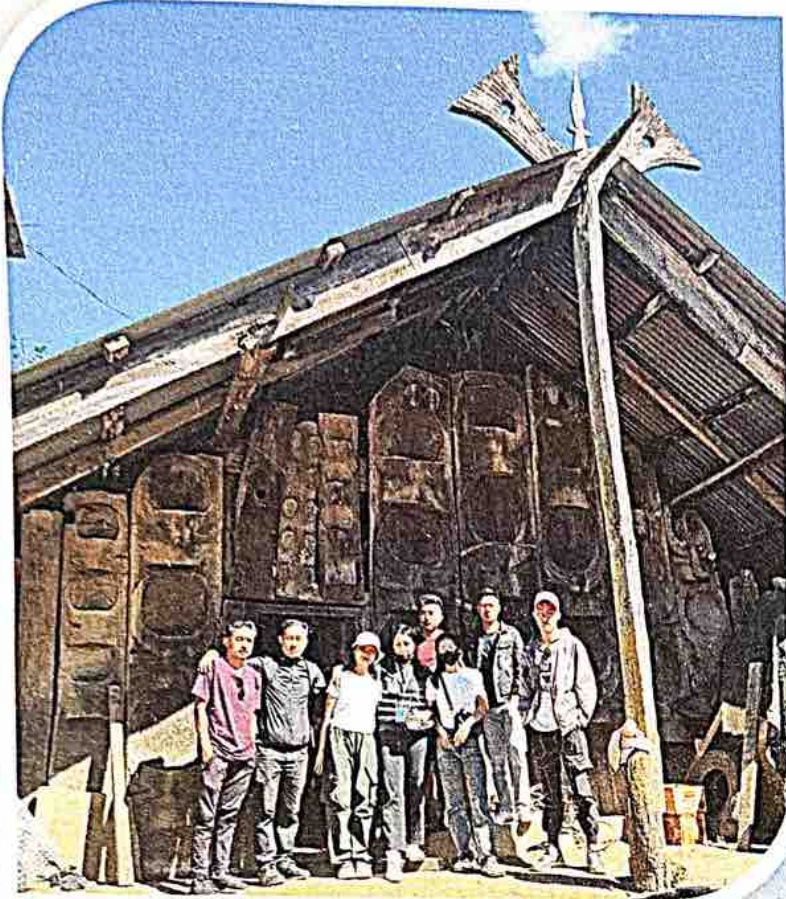
The Department of History organized a field trip to Khezhakeno Village and Chida Post on November 13, 2024. Six students from the BA 6th semester, accompanied by two faculty members, participated in this educational excursion.

During the visit, the participants explored several historically and culturally significant sites deeply rooted in early Naga heritage. These included the **Tsopoupe Chitude Kebe** (the mythical growing stone), which holds legendary significance in Naga folklore, and **Mowo Ke** (the Chief Priest's home), a place associated with traditional religious practices and spiritual leadership. They also visited **Zhi Nhakalake** (Nose of the Lake), a site of natural and cultural importance, and **Kelhe Dzukho** (Sanctification Pond), believed to have played a crucial role in ancient Naga purification rituals.

In addition to these historical visits, the participants embarked on a nature walk to Chida Post, a site renowned for its scenic beauty and historical relevance. This walk provided them with an opportunity to appreciate the breathtaking landscapes while immersing themselves in the rich past of the region.

REPORT ON NIT TO MUMBAI, PUNE, GOA

On February 9, 2025, the students and staff visited the Naval Dockyard, where they were given a submarine tour and a comprehensive explanation of warship operations. They also explored the Heritage Hall, where they learned about the history of Mumbai's Naval Dockyard.

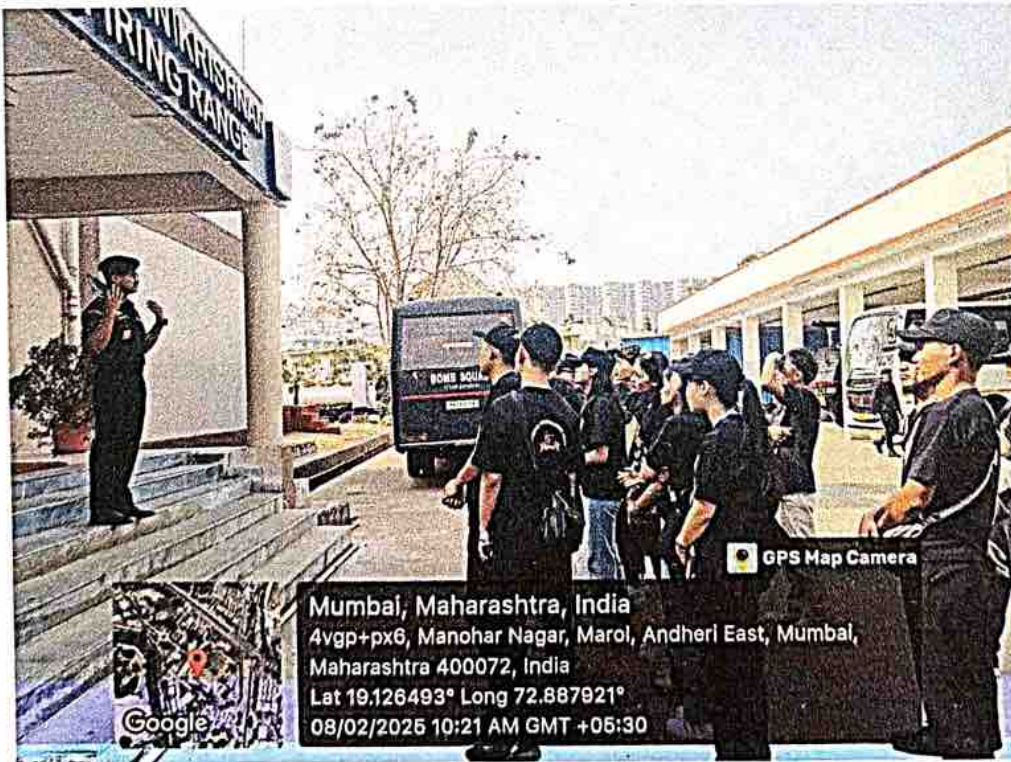

REPORT ON FIELD TRIP TO DOYANG RIVER

A two-day field trip to Doyang River, Wokha, was organized by the Department of Political Science and History on the 14th and 15th of March, 2025. The group consisting of 17 students from BA 6th Semester and three faculty members, departed from the college at 8am on March 14 and returned on March 15 at 6pm. The primary objective was to enhance practical learning beyond the classroom, provide exposure to real-world experiences, and offer students a refreshing break from their academic routine.

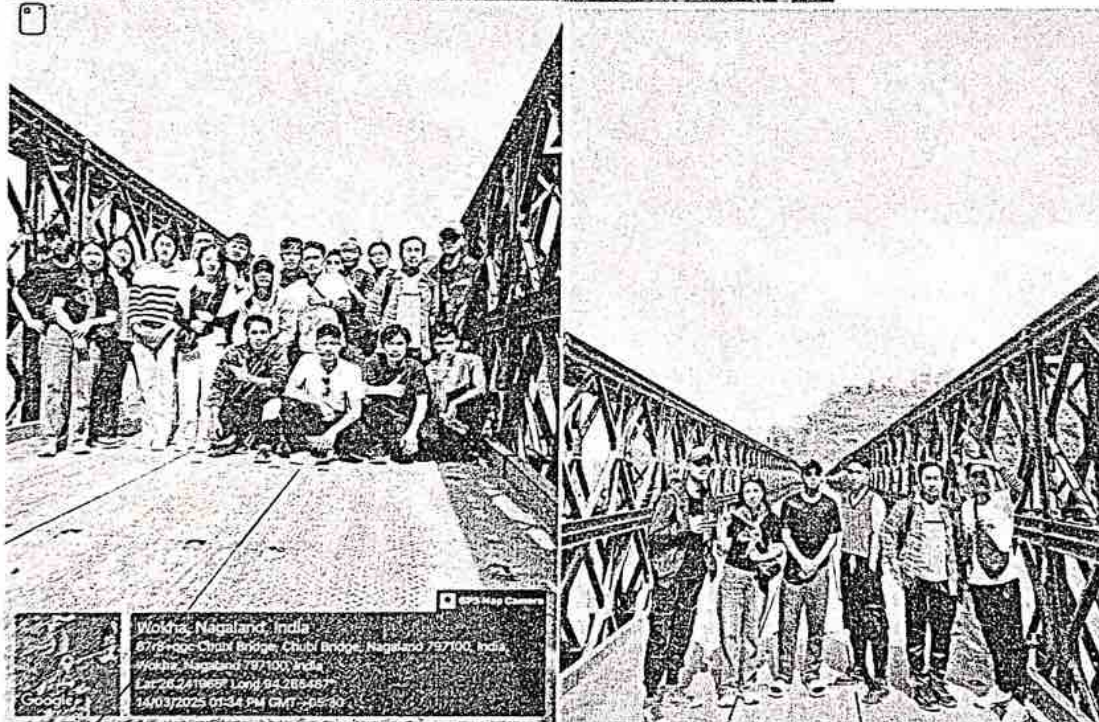
