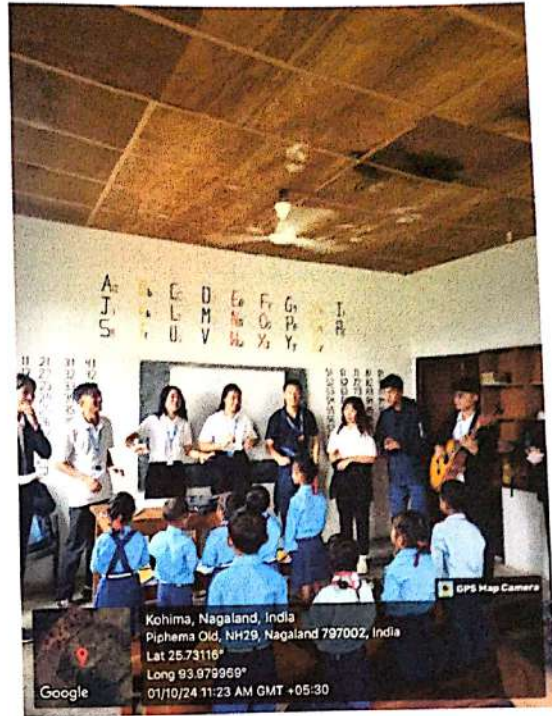
REPORT ON GOVT. PRIMARY SCHOOL VISITATION BY NSS IN COLLABORATION WITH RRC

NSS REPORT ON THE POSHAN PAKHWADA 2025

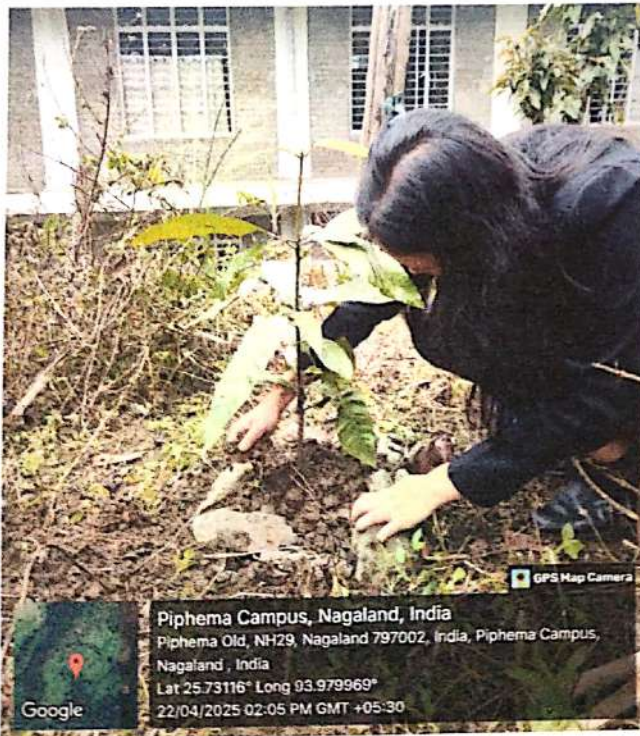
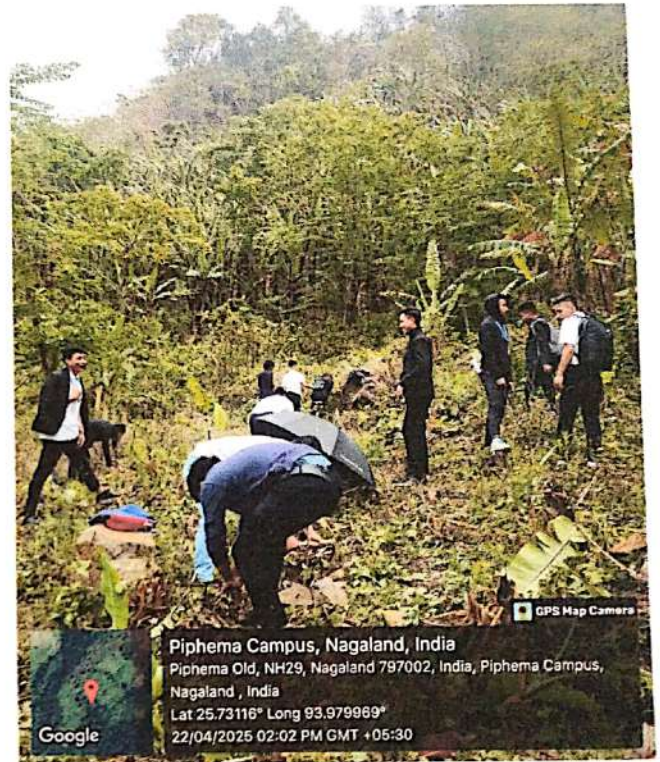
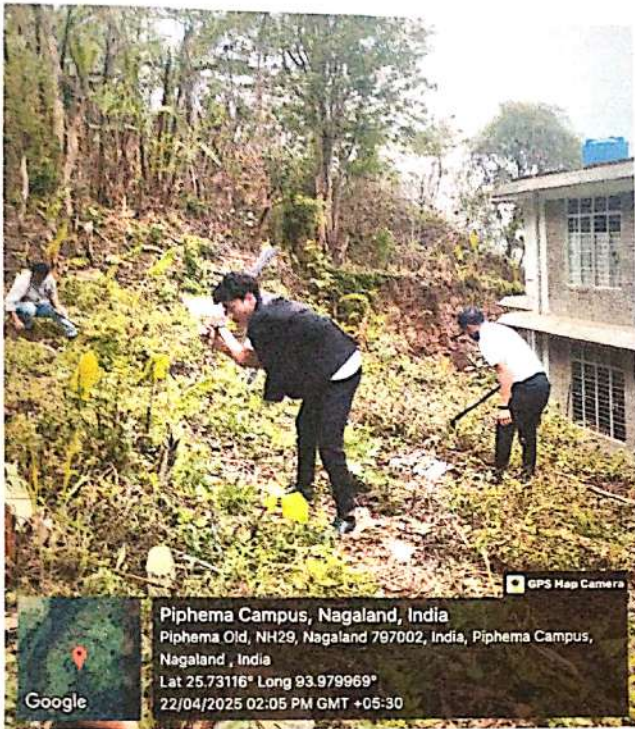

NSS Report on Ambedkar Jayanti 2025 Modern College.

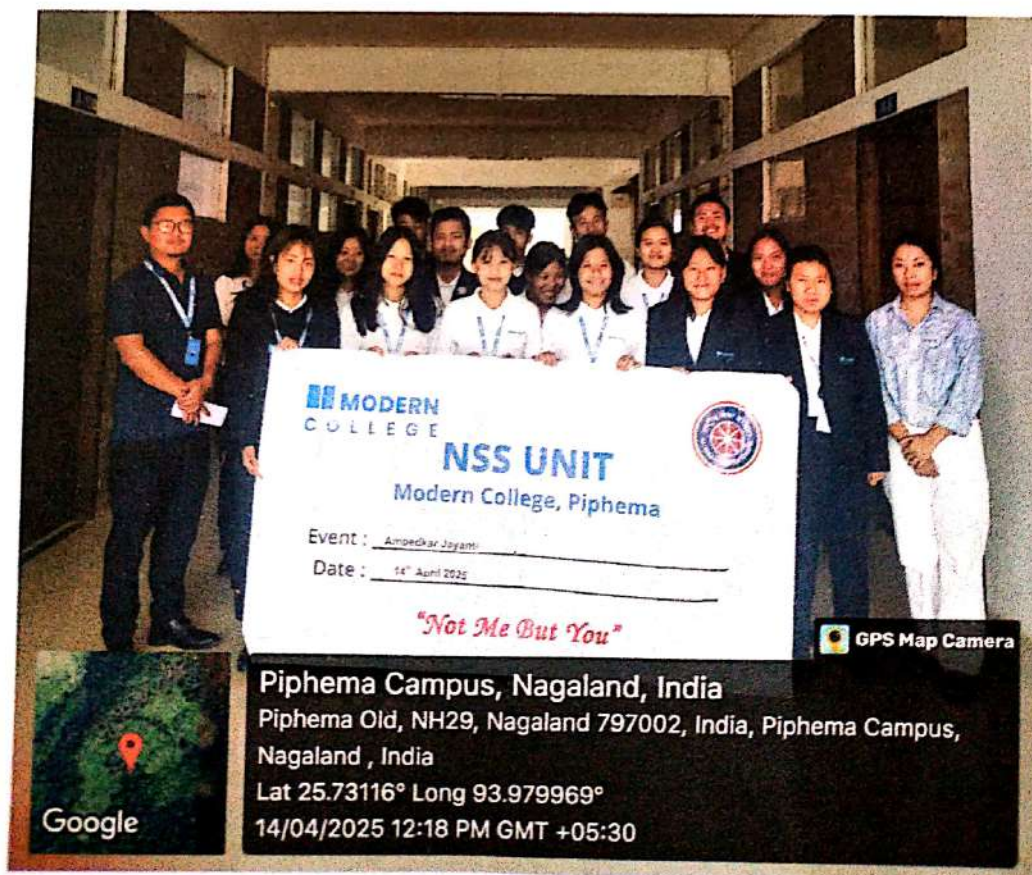
