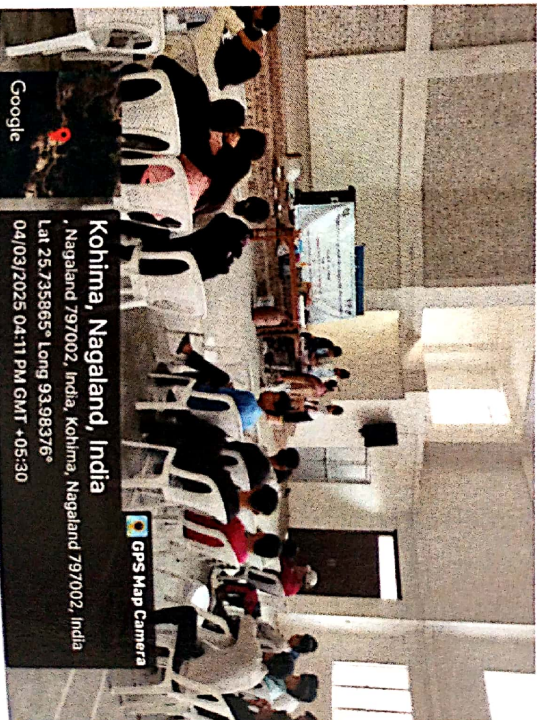
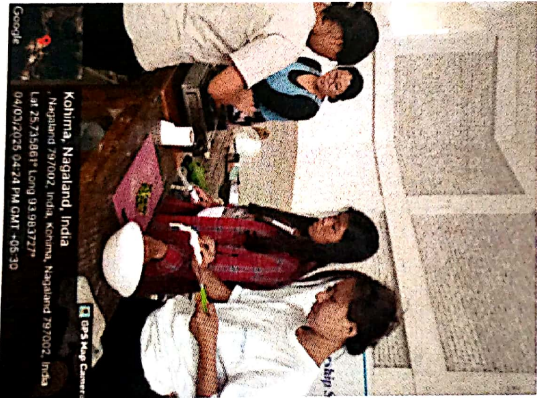
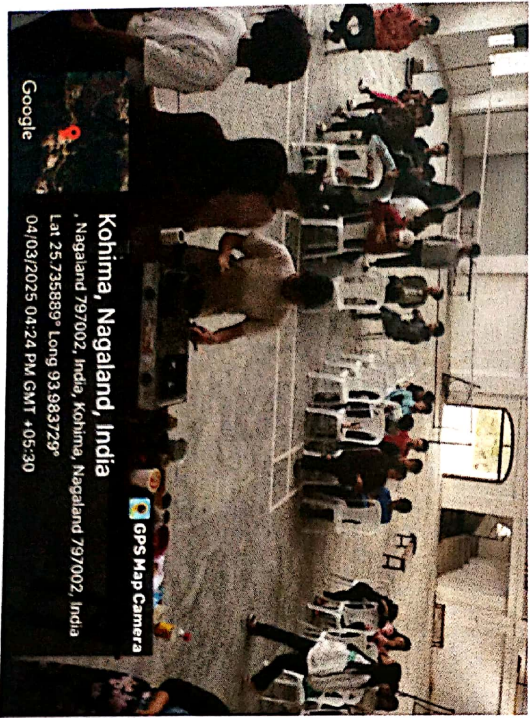
05 INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME
