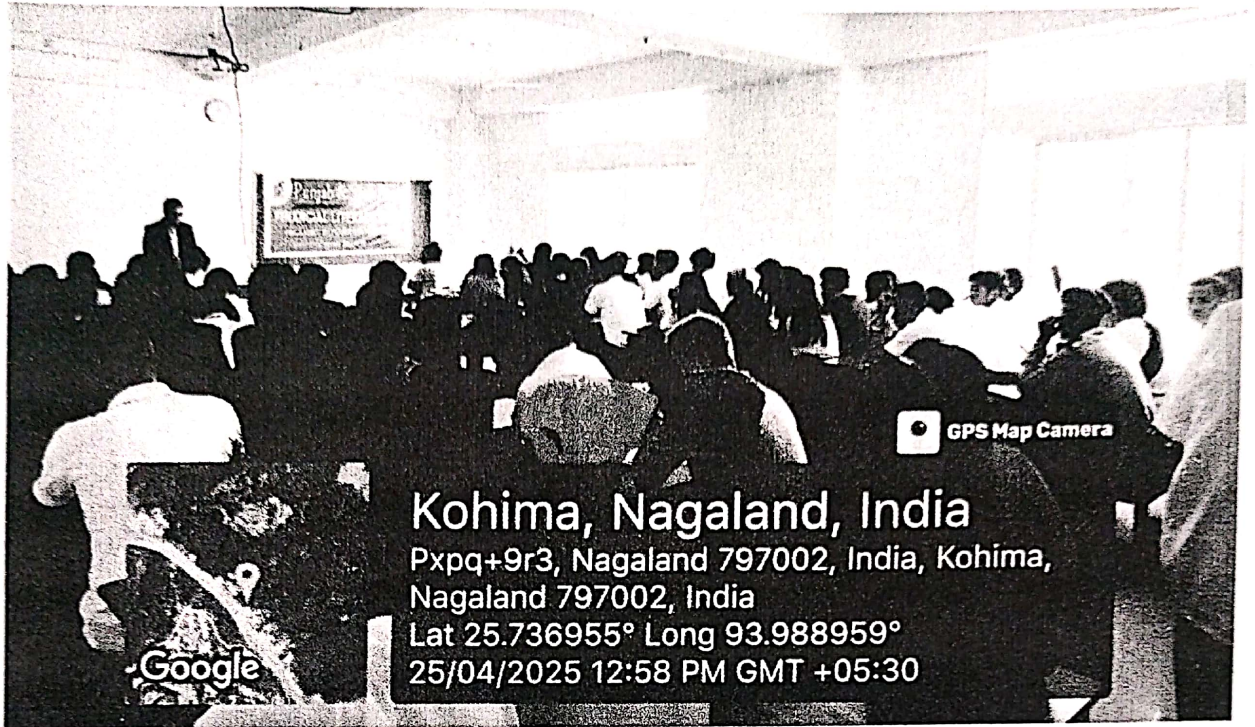

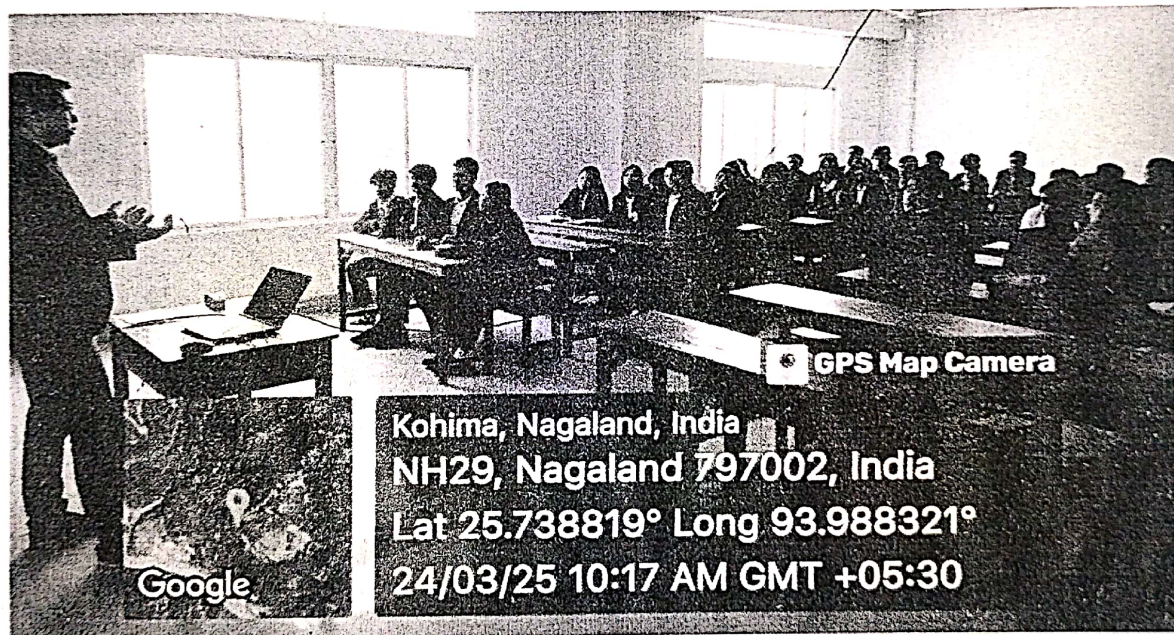

The Career Guidance Cell along with the Alumni Association Modern College conducted a career counseling cum student interaction with Mr. Takanunba Pongen, alumnus from the BVoc Batch of 2022. Mr Takanunba Pongen completed his Post Graduate Programme in Management from IIM Bangalore. He is placed at Kraft Heinz Ahmedabad as Data Analyst.

He gave an inspirational and motivation talk to the students on "Learning from Failures". He told students that failures are a part of life and it contributes to the growth and development of an individual. It is from failures and mistakes that one learns lessons. One should not perceive failures as something negative, rather take make improvements and move forward. Having a growth mindset is a must for one to move forward and achieve success.

He narrated his own journey of how he achieved success despite failures. To him, failures did not let him define who he is. Rather he took those setbacks, worked on them everyday and improved on his deficiencies in a gradual manner and converted them into comebacks. He advised students on how to take it one at a time. 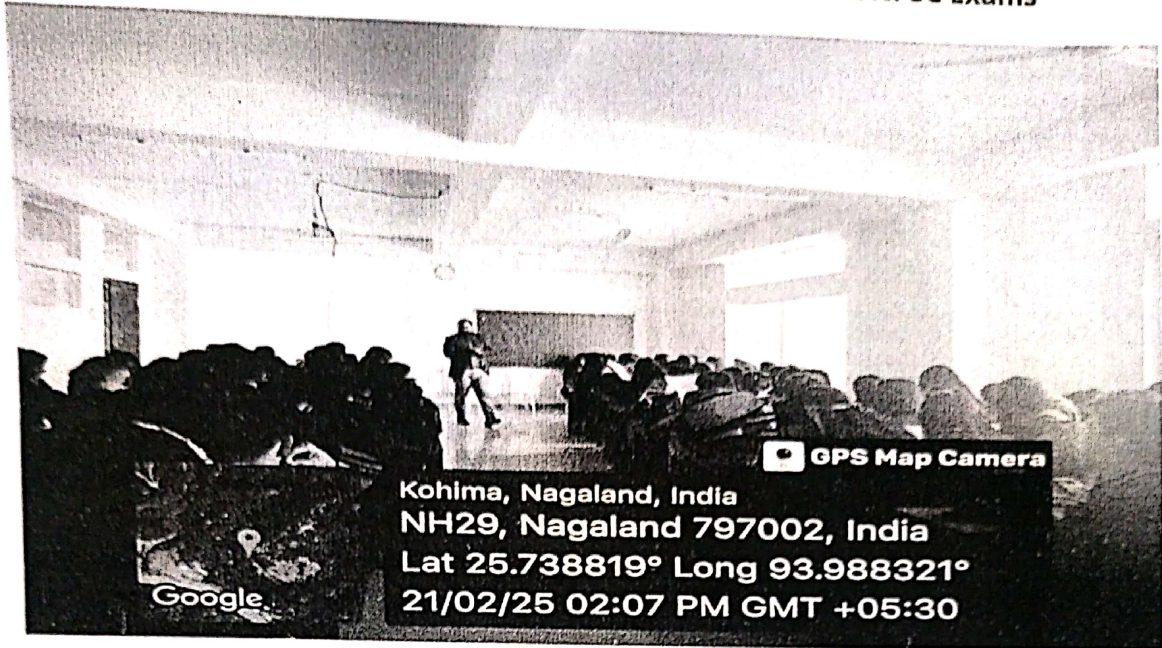

## Students Career Counseling on Preparation for UPSC/NPSC Exams



The Imperial IAS Academy, Kohima team conducted a career counseling for students from the sixth semester on 21/02/2025 Friday. The team comprised of Mr. Sachin Barwal, Academic Director, Imperial IAS Academy, Mr Moasunep, Academic Counsellor, Ms Betonika, Academic Counselor; and Mr Anato Sema, Marketing Head.

Mr Sachin Barwal gave the detailed presentation on the perks of getting into the Union Public Service Commission and as to why students should aspire to write and crack the toughest exam in the country. He spoke at length about the exam structure – the Prelims and the Mains, the pattern, the subjects to be selected for the Mains. He then also spoke about the nature of the interview and gave a sense on how the panel interview prospective candidates.

Further, he also spoke on the second type of the exam which the NPSC exam conducted at the state level. He talked about the different types of posts held by those who clear the exams at the state level. He gave an overview of the structure of the NPSC exams – the Prelims and the Mains. He then apprised the students on the difference between the UPSC and the NPSC examinations.

For those students who aspire to be a Civil Servant, he said that the IAS Academy can guide and mentor them to prepare in an organized manner. He spoke of the successful candidates who have been associated with the academy. He also spoke about the provisions for students at the Academy – that they can have lifetime access to the library, they have special lectures and guidance from officers.

The programme was conducted by the Career Counseling, Training & Placement Cell. Ms Chanini Lokho, Convenor chaired the programme and proposed the Vote of Thanks. A total of 87 students attended the programme.

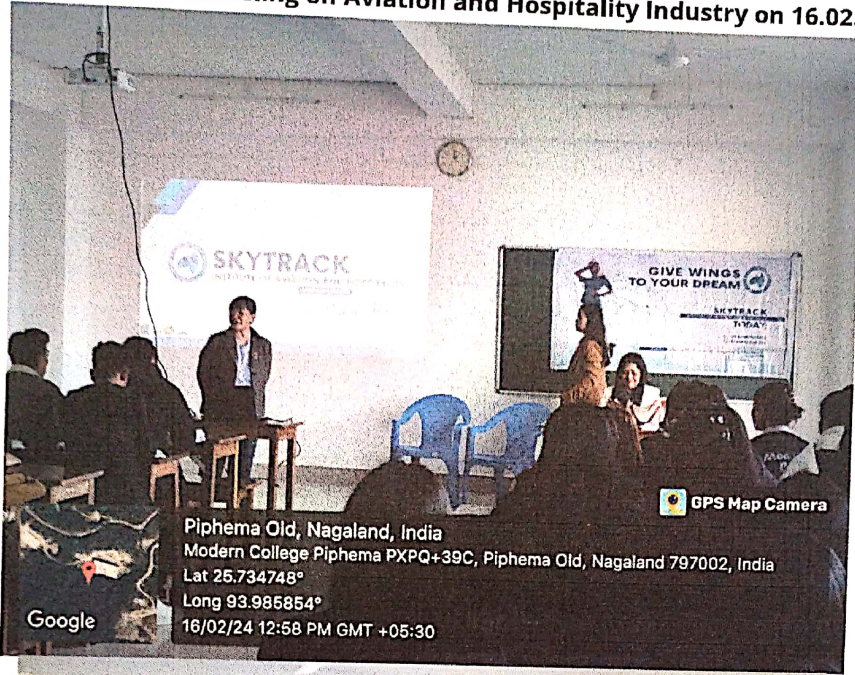

### Students Career Counseling on Aviation and Hospitality Industry on 16.02.2024

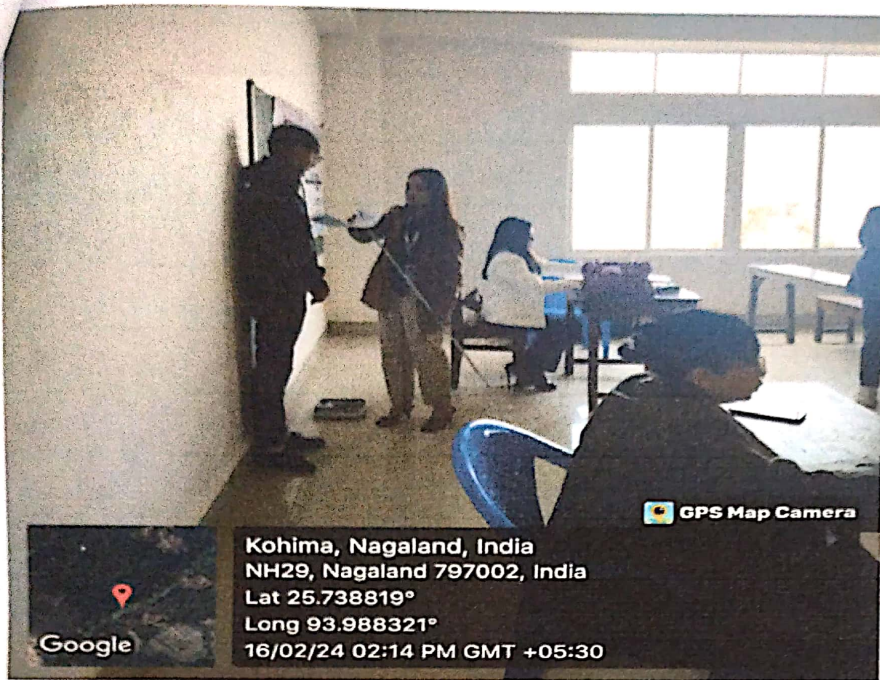


### Students Career Counseling on Joining the Indian Army on 23.01.2024

Major Akashdeep Attri from the 7 Assam Rifles, Ghaspani addressed the students and faculty members of Modern College on the 75<sup>th</sup> Republic Day Celebration at the Indoor Stadium on 24 January, 2024. In the first part of the address, the Major reminded the audience on the significance of the Republic Day and its celebration in the country. The second part of the address mainly focused on reminding the students on the importance of having a good academic performance and motivating them to join the Armed force in the Indian Army. In his presentation, he touched upon aspects as to why as young Indians, and students, they should aspire to join the Indian Army as it is a very reputable and honourable profession. He highlighted on the amenities and facilities, perks and exposure programmes such as varied adventure sports which comes on joining the Indian Army. He said that on joining the Indian Army one can be a part of the joint training exercises, be in the United Nations Mission, and various other exchange programmes internationally.

Mr John Besii, Administrator chaired the programme and the Ms Vini Achumi, IQAC Coordinator proposed the vote of thanks.

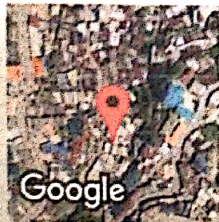
Altogether 150 students from the BA and BVoc programme along with 20 faculty members joined the programme.

ORGANIZED BY THE IQAC AND ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, MODERN COLLEGE**



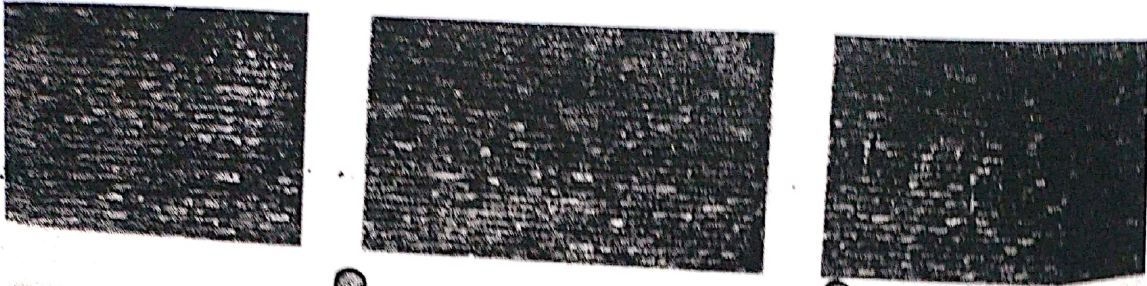
The speech was immediately followed by a Q&A session wherein there was a flow of quite interesting series of questions from the audience to which the resource person answered justifiably.

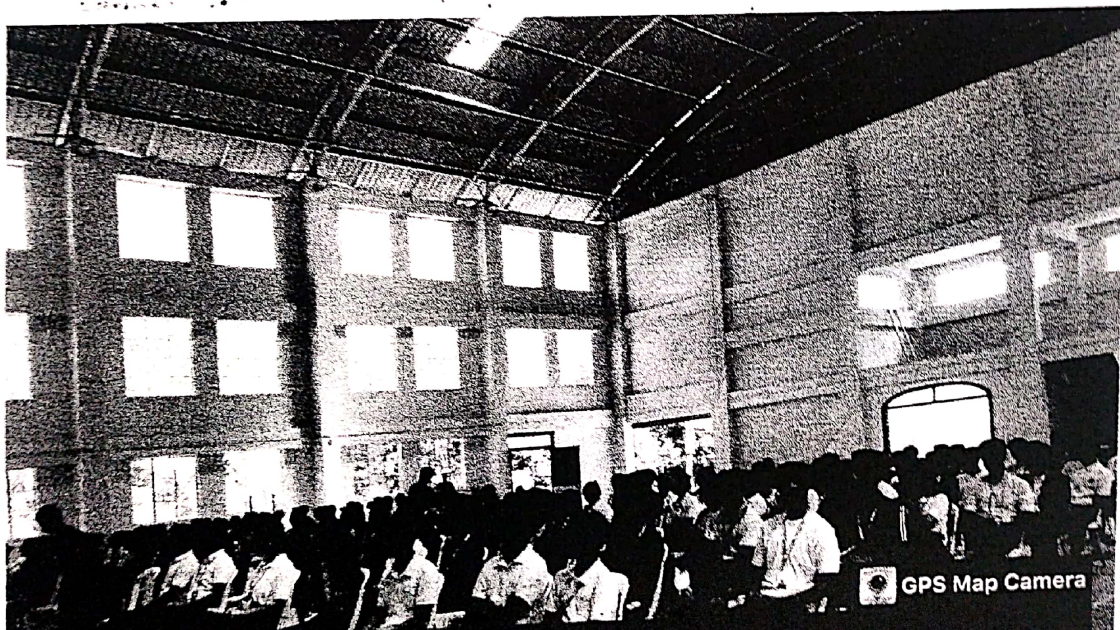

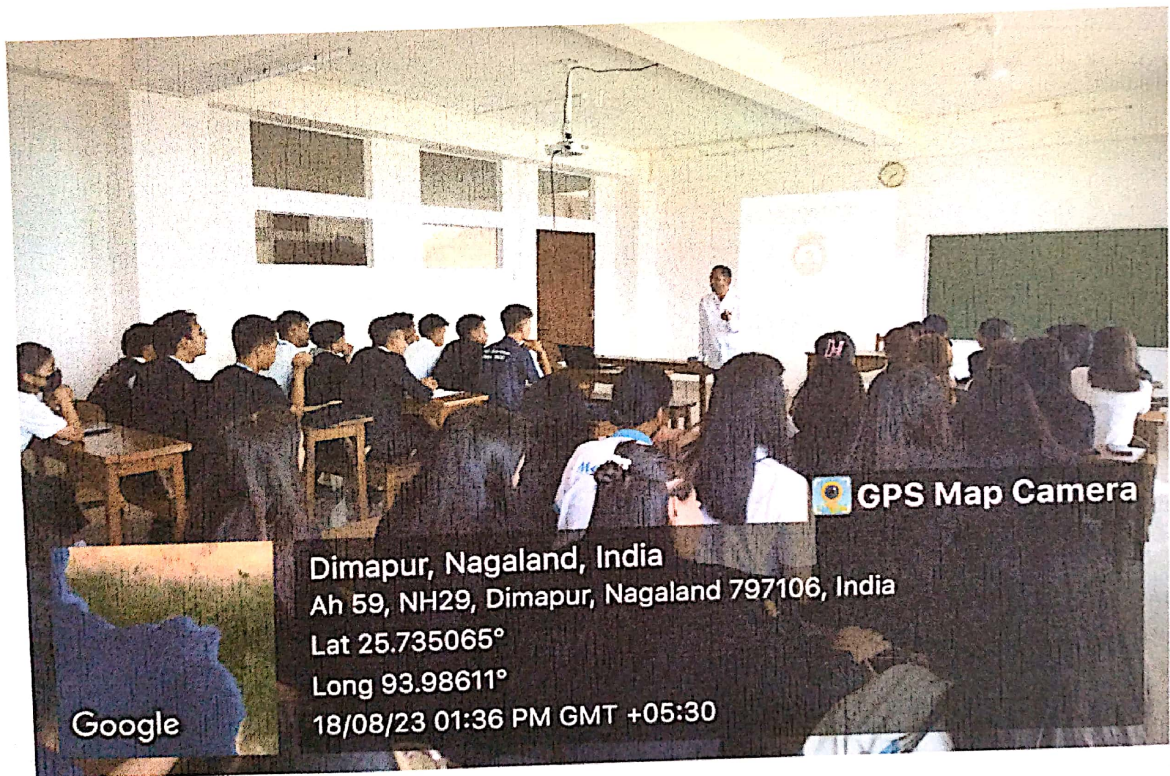
All together 51 students from the 5<sup>th</sup> Semesters participated in the program.
