In the men's category for 10K Mini Marathon race, Mr. Thonga Cheirin secured the first position, winning a cash prize of Rs. 15,000. Mr. Shivangi T. Khamniungam in second position with a cash prize of Rs. 10,000 and the third position went to Mr. Ngaopulon with a cash prize of Rs. 5,000. In women's category for 6K Mini Marathon race, the first position was bagged by Ms. Songmo P winning a cash prize of Rs. 10,000. Ms. Niansi T. claimed second position with a cash prize of Rs. 7,000 and Ms. Peiheiteilie secured the third position with a cash prize of Rs. 5,000. The race covering a designated roundabout route from Dairy Farm Point, Modern College to Cultural Hall, Piphema (A).
