State Level Workshop on "Students' Assessment and Evaluation" was organized by IQAC Kohima Science College on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2023 at the Conference Hall under the sub theme of

- i. Levels of Objectives for Educational Evaluation.
- ii. Forms of Questions for Educational Evaluation
- iii. Marking Schemes.

The Workshop was attended by Ms. Mongsenchila Asst. Professor from the department of History and Ms. Vini Achumi IQAC Co-ordinator of Modern College.

The workshop was divided into two technical sessions followed by the Q&A. The Resource Person for the Workshop was Dr. Bendangyapangla Associate Professor, SCTE, Ms. Anisha Himb, Assistant Professor SCTE and Mr. Tepusa Kiso, Assistant Professor SCTE.

The workshop focused on the Educational Endeavor determining what to accomplish and to align goals and objectives. Benjamin Bloom an educationalist said that there are 3 domain of Educational Objective

- i. Cognitive Domain- Mental intellectual
- ii. Affective Domain- attitude, feeling or emotions
- iii. Psychomotor domain- physical or manual skills.

He also developed levels of thinking and verbs that can be used in a learning objectives. The 6 levels of thinking includes

- i. Remembering
- ii. Understanding
- iii. Applying
- iv. Analyzing
- v. Evaluating
- vi. Creating.

Various Tools and Techniques which can be used by an educator to evaluate different forms of questions were also discussed along with the suggestions. The different Marking schemes were also discussed stating that Marking is acknowledging the student's work. The concluding remarks for an evaluation noted on "Evaluation is Justice to All".

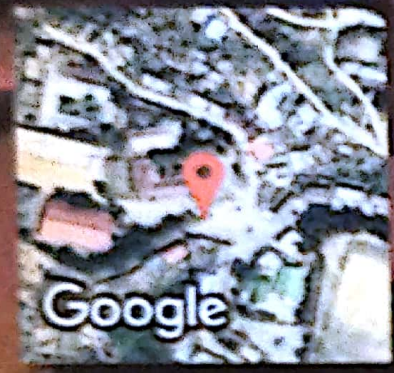

Workshop on "Non Verbal Aspects of Communication".

The IQAC Modern College, Piphema organized a Workshop for both the Teaching and Non-Teaching faculty of the college on "Non Verbal Aspects of Communication" on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2024, at the college.. The workshop divided into 3 sessions. The first session was on Body language where the resource person focused on movement, postures, gestures, eye contact and facial expressions. It is stated that during communication 7% of words are effective, Body language is effective by 55% and Vocal elements are effective by 38%. Avoid shaking, swaying, Twiddling, strengthening the message, being life to what you say, building trust, making eye contact and expressing your emotions to match with your conversation are few important keys for good communication skills.

The second session was on Vocal elements focusing on the volume, pace, pause, fillers and tones. During a conversation it is important not to speak too fast or too slow. An average of 150 words per minute is encouraged. While having a conversation pausing is important with an optimum time of 2 seconds. Pause between sections, to breathe and think and to allow the audience to absorb. One key factor which is important is that its not what you say but how you say while having a conversation.


The last session was on Training of trainers. This workshop was an eye opener for all the participants and a learning experience for everyone.

The resource person for the Workshop was Mr. Worrin Muivah Founder and CEO Step Academy. The moderator for the event was Mr. Teisovi Domeh Asst. Professor Dept. of Sociology, Welcome address was proposed by Dr. Vitsou Yano Principal, Words of Gratitude was proposed by Ms. Chanini Lokho Executive Director and the recorder for the Workshop was Ms. Vini Achumi IQAC Co-ordinator.
