



Awareness Programme on Prevention of Sexual Harassment

In an effort to promote a safe and inclusive environment, the Gender Champion Club and Anti Sexual Harassment Cell organised an awareness programme on "Prevention of Sexual Harassment" on 6th September, 2024 in the college Indoor Stadium.


The event aimed at educating students and staff on understanding, identifying, and preventing sexual harassment in academic and professional spaces. Dr. Vitsou Yano, Principal, Modern College was the resource person for the awareness program. In her speech, Dr. Yano delved into the legal framework designed to combat sexual harassment and outlined the Act's core mandates: Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal.

She also emphasised the need for educational institutions to proactively create safe and inclusive environment to prevent any kind of harassment. She focussed on the three types of sexual harassment i.e. physical contact, verbal actions and non-verbal actions.

Dr. Yano also stressed on the importance of creating a safe place for victims to come forward without fear of retaliation or stigma, which remains a major barrier in many institutions.

The programme was a resounding success, leaving a lasting impact on the audience by highlighting the importance of creating safe spaces for open dialogue and equipped the students and staff of Modern College with the knowledge and tools necessary to contribute to a harassment-free environment.

All together 166 students and 19 faculty members attended the programme.

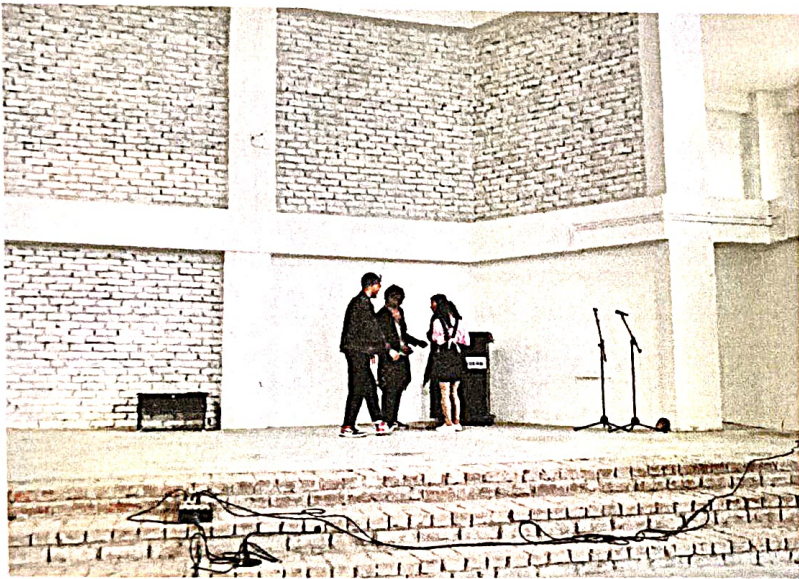

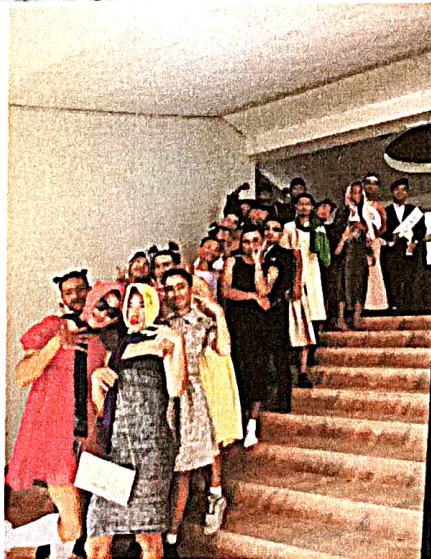
