NSS Report on Ambedkar Jayanti 2025 Modern College.

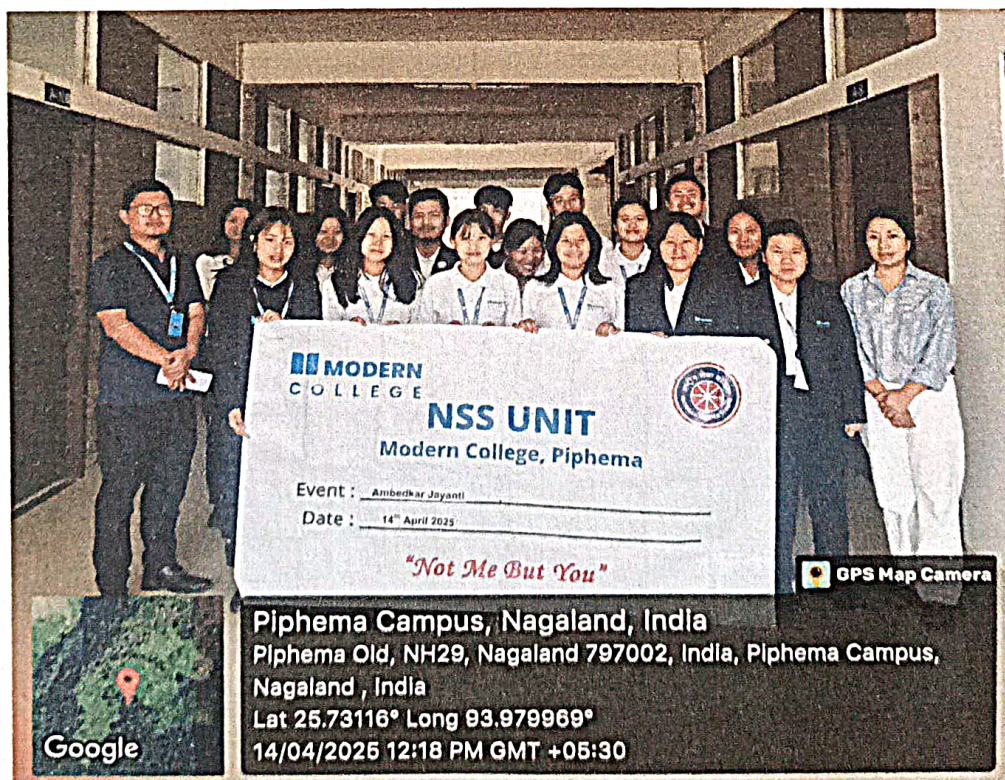

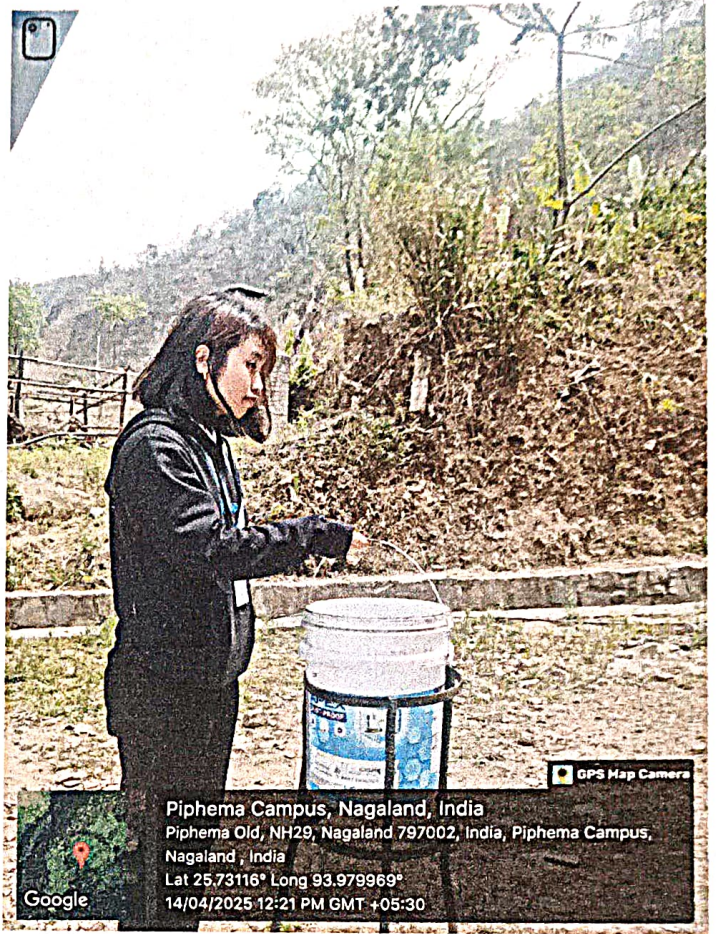

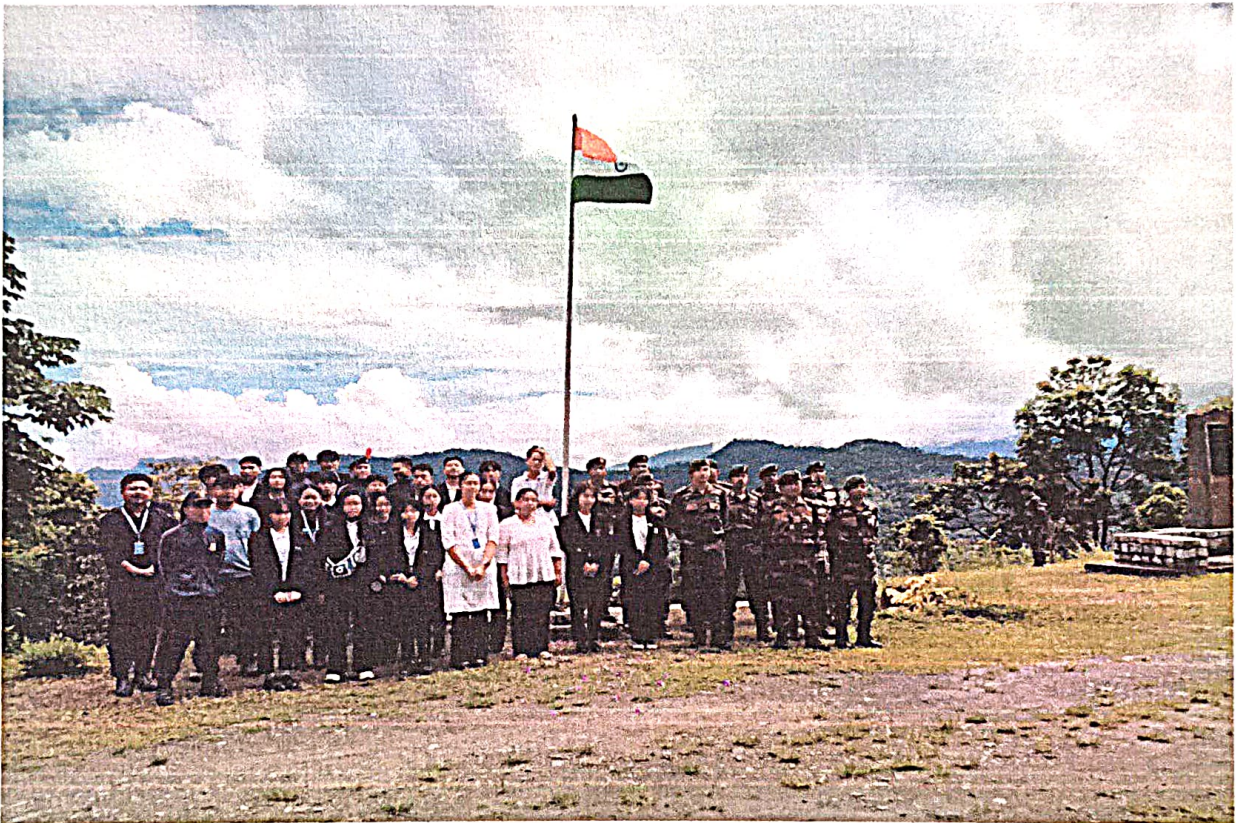

Report on Awareness Lecture-Operation Sindoor


The 22 Assam Rifles Battallion In collaboration with NCC, Modern College organised a program on "Operation Sindoor" on 20/09/25. The program was part of an initiative to raise awareness among students about national security, counter-terrorism, and the role of the armed forces in preserving peace and sovereignty. Captain Nemish gave an elaborate presentation on the operation which was launched in response to the Pahalgam terrorist attack (6th-7th May 2025), which claimed 26 civilian lives.

The session included detailed presentation that showcased the courage, planning, and sacrifices of the Indian Armed Forces and the persistent threat posed by Pakistan-based terror organisations, highlighting how Pakistan's internal instability often fuels cross-border terrorism aimed at disturbing peace in Jammu & Kashmir. The lecture made reference to past major terrorist attacks, including the 2008 Mumbai attacks and the Pulwama attack in 2019, providing students with a broader context of the challenges India has faced in combating terrorism.

Captain Namish also shared data on terrorist casualties, civilian losses, and the ultimate sacrifices made by Indian soldiers. He spoke about the abrogation of Article 370 in 2019 and how it marked a turning point in the progress and development of Jammu & Kashmir. He emphasized the positive changes seen in the region post-abrogation, including improved infrastructure, security, and governance.

In addition to military operations and political developments, the lecture also touched upon the importance of digital literacy. Students were urged not to blindly trust social media but to verify facts before forming opinions, especially on issues related to national security. His message was a powerful reminder of the impact misinformation can have on public perception and national unity.

Overall, the lecture was highly informative and motivating. It provided students with a deeper understanding of national defence strategies, counter-terrorism efforts, and the immense sacrifices made by the Indian Armed Forces. The session left a lasting impression, inspiring a sense of patriotism and responsibility among the attendees.
