The programme ended with a vote of thanks by Mr. Kevingukho Kehie, Assistant Professor, Dept of History who is an active member of the Red Ribbon Club.


The last session of the awareness programme was the HIV screening where altogether 26 students and staff participated willingly.

Report of the Panel Discussion On Vision of NEP 2020 in Nagaland

Organized by Nagaland Education Association

29th July, 2023

The National Education Policy of India 2020 (NEP 2020) which was started by the Union Cabinet of India on 29th July 2020, outlines the vision of new education system of India. The new policy replaces the previous National Policy on Education, 1986. Based on this new policy, a Panel Discussion on Vision of NEP 2020 in Nagaland was organized by Nagaland Education Association on 29th July, 2023 at 11:00 a.m at the Directorate of School Education, Kohima. It was attended by six students along with one faculty from our college. The following attendees were

The program started with the moderator Dr.Ketoukhrie-ü, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Kohima Government College introducing the participants of the program. The first Panelist i.e., Dr.Khotole Khieya, Associate Professor, Department of Education, NU puts on the table the following points on NEP 2020 for discussion. Some of it includes -structure of education, NEP a multi-disciplinary, digital initiative, course through online mode, single regulatory system for the entire higher education, equity access and inclusion in higher education etc. The second panelist, Dr. Bendangyapangla, Associate Professor, State College of Teacher Education, Kohima mentioned that NEP 2020 is concern with the improvement and prestige of the teacher, teacher's training, recruitment and empowering the teachers. She highlighted the following points by saying teachers will be given more autonomy to choose the pedagogy of the classroom under the NEP 2020 but also commented on it whether it is practically possible and will the school allow it. Some other points mentioned by her under NEP were all other courses to be available in teacher education, envisioned TET for all stages of preparation both for private and government teachers, availability of academic positions to the teachers and so forth. The third panelist Dr.Medongoi Rhakho, Deputy Director, Higher Education, Nagaland started his orate by saying Nagaland have neglected the professional education and overemphasized on general education. But NEP emphasized on professional education which is a positive factor for us. He also mentions on the four pillars, vertical bodies, vision and implementation on NEP 2020.

After which time was open for interactions and discussions. Various questions, opinions and suggestions were put forward and discussed in depth about the vision of NEP 2020 in Nagaland considering the various challenges and limitations of the education system in Nagaland. Madam Dr.Khotole also featured us with the Digilocker app which will help the students to store their academic credits and encouraged to open an account through the official website. It was concluded by Dr. Neizekhonuo Liezietsu, Assistant Professor, State College of Teacher Education, Kohima by presenting the concluding remarks of the program.








Mr. Anthony with organizers and some students


National Youth Day and Youth Week: **ESSAY COMPETITION** held at Modern College

Prizes for the competition are Rs. 1,500 and Rs. 1000 for 1st and 2nd position respectively.

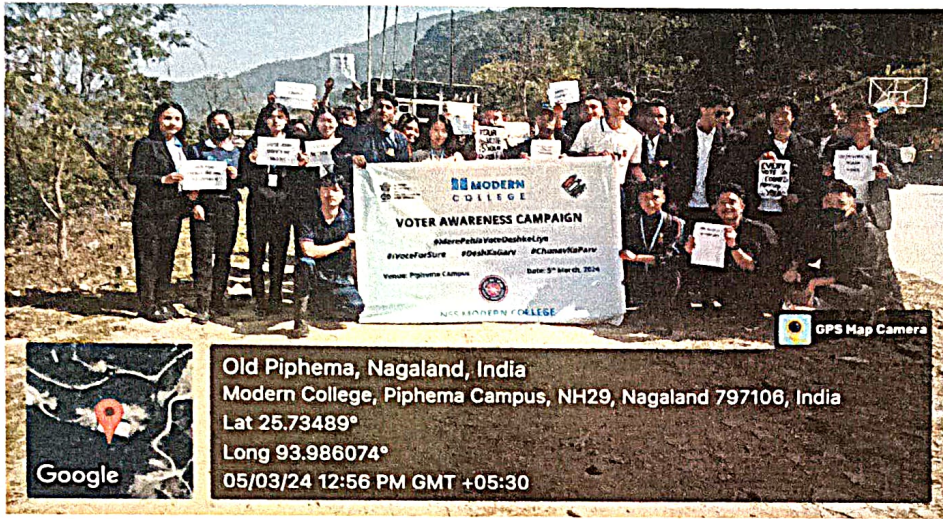
