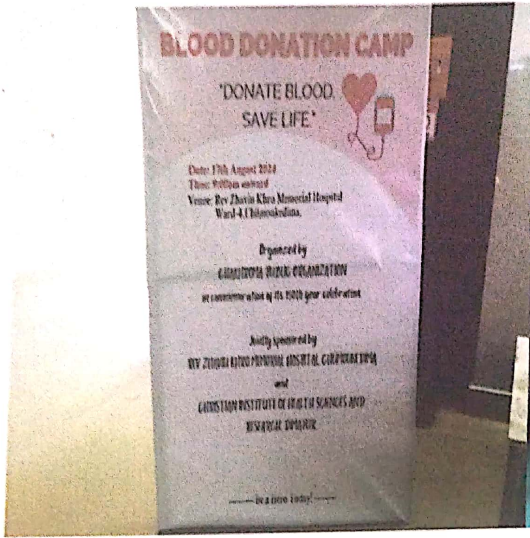

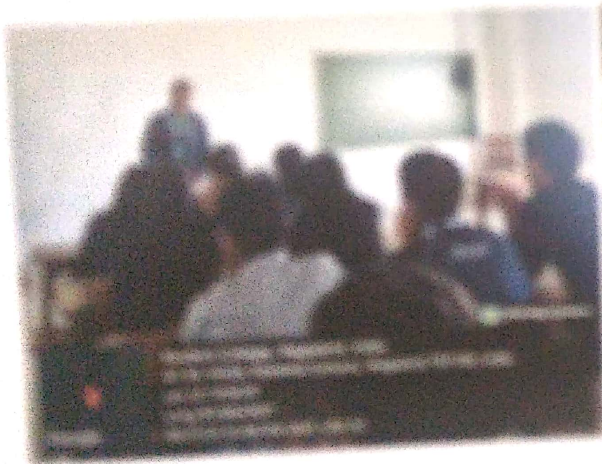
NIS Modern College in Collaboration with the Political Science Department Observes National Constitution Day

2nd Prize – Ms. Rothrongu Sangtam of B.A 5th semester



NSS Report on Ambedkar Jayanti 2025 Modern College.

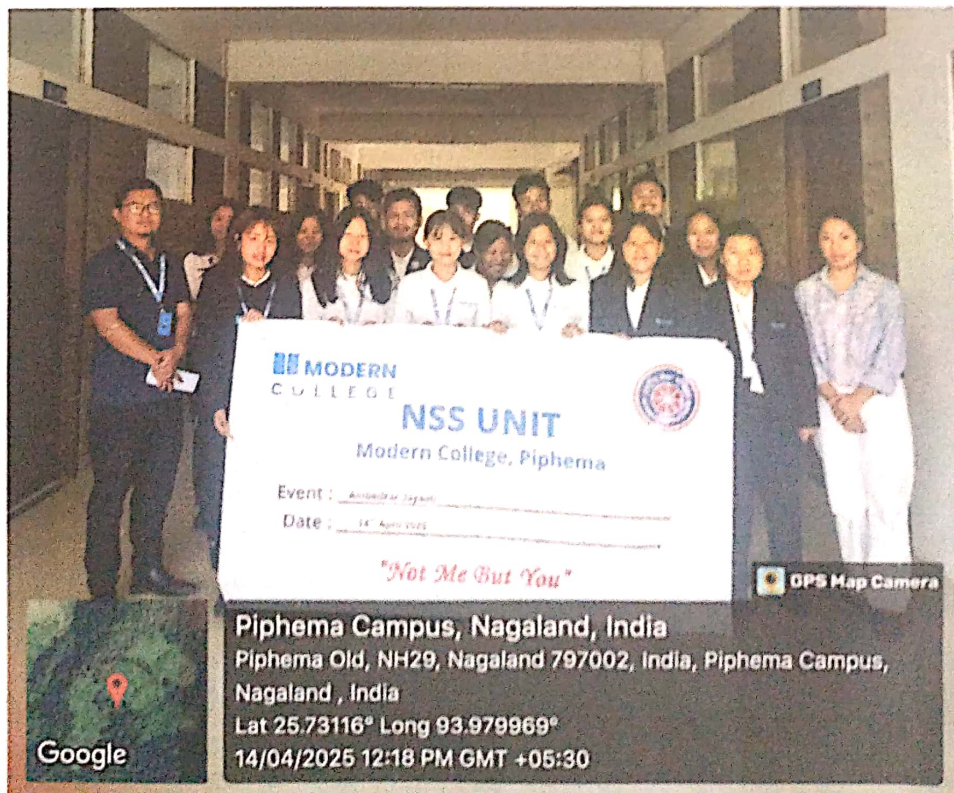

Science followed by presentations on 'Opportunities and Prospects under IGNOU' by Dr. Premila Swami D. Regional Director, IGNOU RC-20 Kohima. Dr. Mayonmi Shimray Asst. Regional Director, IGNOU RC-20 Kohima also highlighted on the 'Dual Programme Provision under NEP 2020'. The presentations were followed by the 'Mock Parliament' session performed by the 3rd and the 5th Sem. Pol. Science (Hon) students. Report on National Education Day 2025

The Department of Education, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Modern College, organized a programme on National Education Day on 11th November 2025. The event was chaired by Mr. Keneingulie Medoze, IQAC Coordinator. An overview was presented by Ms. Cilule Ndong, Assistant Professor, who highlighted that National Education Day commemorates the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, India's first Education Minister. She emphasized his significant contributions to India's educational foundations, including institutions such as the UGC and AICTE, and reflected on the day's relevance in acknowledging progress and ongoing challenges in the education sector.

Mr. Sedevikho Keyho, IT Instructor from NITI, delivered a talk titled "AI and Education: Human Agency in an Automated World." He discussed the expanding role of artificial intelligence in education and urged students to embrace technological advancement while safeguarding creativity and critical thinking. He explained how AI is transforming learning through adaptive systems, automated assessments, and data-driven insights. While these innovations support personalized learning and reduce teachers' workload, he noted concerns related to diminished student agency, algorithmic bias, privacy issues, and reduced teacher autonomy. He emphasized the need for learners to remain active decision-makers and for teachers to continue serving as ethical mentors and designers of meaningful learning experiences. He concluded by emphasizing the need for a balanced partnership between humans and AI; one that strengthens education while preserving human judgment and creativity.

The programme concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Ms. Linovi Kinimi, who expressed gratitude to all participants and organizers for their contributions to the successful conduct of the event.
